 - Helping diverse individuals build their innovation skills and/or under-resourced organizations build and use technology to increase their impact
 - Helping to make your community more resilient and tech-prepared

ALL TEAMS THAT RECEIVE FUNDING FROM THIS GRANT AGREE TO:

- Sign a photo and video release waiver.
- Submit an accounting of expenses that this grant funded as a Microsoft Word document or Excel spreadsheet.
- Submit a 3-5-minute video detailing the team's journey, how the team advanced Diversity, Innovation, & Community Resilience; and the impact that these initiatives had on the team and community.
- Include the Booz Allen Hamilton logo on the team shirts and robot, in the team pit, and on the team website and any social media page and will be provided.
- Abide by Sponsor's rules for use of logo and branding (provided).
